

SAY NO to trading Summit Ave trees for a paved bike trail!

St. Paul City Parks and Recreation department is pushing a “Master Plan for Summit Avenue”. This plan involves carving out 10 feet of existing boulevard and trees to create a paved bike trail to connect other existing regional bike trails to the trail along Mississippi Boulevard. Some street parking could also be lost. Help protect the longest stretch of Victorian architecture in the nation!

Proposed timeline: Final design – June 2022; City Council Vote – Fall 2022
